### RATIONALE

The Whyalla Special Education Centre Governing Council has endorsed the policy of school uniform for all students.

A school uniform for students provides:

Identification with the school

A sense of pride in belonging to this school

Assistance in the provision of a safe school environment (students are easily identified at public events, excursions, off site learning)

A cost effective, durable clothing option

### UNIFORM OPTIONS

Whyalla Special Education Centre is a sun-safe school with a dress code that promotes safety and inclusiveness. While the school orders school shirts, jumpers with the logo embroidered logo, families have the option to find suitable shirts and jumpers of the same colour that supports the sensory needs of their child. Students who cannot wear the uniform due to sensory concerns need to have this documented in their NEP.
